Dear Parents,

We are delighted that we are able to reopen on Monday next March 1st for Junior Infants, Senior Infants, First Class and Second Class students.

We would like to congratulate the students on their great work during this time of remote learning. We are very thankful of the wonderful support and dedication shown by all in the school community during these extraordinary times. The teachers were very impressed with the wonderful work completed by students during this period of remote learning.

In order for a smooth and successful reopening of our school we have yet more requests all our school community.

In order to minimise the numbers gathering at the start and the end of school we will continue with the timetable of staggered drop off and collection times.

The timetable is as follows:

To ensure the smooth running of this arrangement, supervision will start at 9:15 a.m., and finish at 3:20p.m. The Board of Management cannot accept responsibility for any pupils on the school premises outside of these hours.

The school buses are operating as normal from Monday. Please note at the present time Ardcarne Community Childcare are unable to operate their Breakfast Club, Small Afterschool (from 2.10pm -3.10pm) or Afterschool (3.10pm-6pm) services.

The Junior Infant and Senior Infant students finish at 2.10 p.m. As there is no Afterschool service from 2.10 pm to 3.10pm at this time all infant students will need to be collected at 2.10pm. The infant teacher uses the remaining hour for class preparation and organisation.

We ask that all students arrive and are collected at agreed times please. We ask that students do not enter the school grounds until a staff member opens and is present at the main school gate. This is to ensure that all students on the school grounds are appropriately supervised.

When pupils are dropped off at the school at their designated time, they must proceed unaccompanied through the open main gate directly to their classroom and are not permitted to congregate/play in the school yard on arrival or on collection from school.

Parents must ensure that appropriate arrangements are put in place for assembly and dismissal of pupils. We ask that all parents adhere to Public Health Guidelines and please do not congregate at the school.

In order to minimise the risk of Introduction of COVID-19 into Schools:

Staff and Pupils are not to return to school or attend school in the event of the following:

- if they display any signs or symptoms of COVID 19
- If they are identified by the HSE as a close contact of a confirmed case of COVID-19
- If they live with someone who has symptoms of the virus
- If they have travelled outside of Ireland: in such instances they are advised to consult and follow the latest Government Advice in relation to foreign travel.
- Staff and pupils must cooperate with any public health officials and the school for contract tracing purposes and follow any public health advice in the event of a case or outbreak in the school.

Pupils and staff will perform hand hygiene:

- On leaving and entering vehicles.
- On arrival and leaving the school.
- Before eating or drinking.
- After using the toilet.
- After playing outdoors.
- When their hands are physically dirty.
- When they cough or sneeze.

We ask that all books/writing equipment are sanitised using alcohol wipes before being placed in the child's schoolbag. Please ensure that all of your child's equipment/books/copies are labelled with the child's name as equipment/books cannot and will not be shared. Please ensure your child has a pencil case for home use and another one for school use. Homework will not be given until after Easter; however, we would strongly encourage each pupil to read as extensively as possible during this time.

We ask that any schoolbooks that are being returned from the home are put in a separate bag please. These will then be put in quarantine/storage for the recommended period of time and sanitised.

Please ensure your child can open/close their own coat and tie their own shoes. Shoes with Velcro should be used where pupils are unable to tie their own. Please label all your child's belongings.

Staff members will wear recommended face coverings. All adult visitors to school grounds MUST WEAR suitable face coverings. There is no requirement for pupils to wear face coverings as of this time.

Communication between home and school will be by e mail, text, Aladdin and through our school website at the moment. Face to face meetings will only be used in exceptional circumstances. If you wish to contact your child's teacher, please email the teacher or leave a message on the school phone (071-9667264). We will endeavour to return your email or call as soon as possible.
